Building a home, extension, commercial property, or other structure starts with more than architectural plans. Because soil conditions can change from one property to another, testing the actual site is more useful than relying only on general information about the surrounding suburb.

Why Is Soil Testing Important on the Gold Coast?

A building transfers its weight into the ground through its foundations. If the ground conditions are not properly understood, the foundation design may not be suitable for the site.

Professional testing can help identify characteristics such as soil classification, ground strength, and potential movement. This information can then be considered by engineers when developing an appropriate foundation design.

A proper investigation may also help identify conditions that could contribute to settlement, movement, drainage problems, or other construction challenges. The exact testing requirements depend on the site and proposed project.

What Can a Soil Test Identify?

The testing process is designed to provide practical information about the ground rather than simply producing a basic soil description. Depending on the project requirements, investigations can examine:

- Soil type and profile at different depths
- Ground strength and bearing characteristics
- Soil reactivity and potential movement
- Existing fill or variable ground conditions
- Moisture and groundwater conditions where relevant
- Site conditions that may affect foundation selection
- Information required for engineering and construction decisions

A DCP test may also be used as part of an investigation to assess soil strength and compaction at different depths. Geotest Group provides DCP testing across Brisbane, Logan, and the Gold Coast.

When Should You Arrange Soil Testing?

Ideally, soil testing should be organised before foundation design and construction work begins. This gives the project team an opportunity to understand the site conditions before important construction decisions are finalised.

It can be particularly relevant when you are:

- Building a new home on vacant land
- Planning a major extension or renovation
- Developing a duplex or multi-unit property
- Preparing a commercial or industrial project
- Purchasing land for future construction
- Working on a site with slopes, fill, or unusual ground conditions

Early testing can also help reduce unexpected changes later in the project because engineers have site-specific information available during the design stage.

How Does the Soil Testing Process Work?

The exact investigation method depends on the property, building type, access, and information required. A typical process starts with reviewing the site and proposed development. Appropriate testing locations and methods can then be selected.

Field testing may involve test holes, sampling, DCP testing, or other geotechnical investigation methods. Where laboratory analysis is required, collected samples can be examined for relevant soil properties.

The findings are then compiled into a report that provides useful information for the project team. Geotest Group states that its services include soil reports, DCP tests, and site classification reports for residential and commercial projects across Southeast Queensland.
